- We would like to take this time to acknowledge that we are on the traditional, unceded territories of the Tsleil-Waututh, Musqueam, and Squamish First Nations and to express my gratitude that we are able to host this event tonight on their beautiful lands.

### Jillian Gordon, Principal

- **Ridgeway Rocks Program:** Focus on reinforcing positive behavior, targeting a 5:1 positive-to-negative feedback ratio. Collective rewards include: Afternoon recess games, sweet treat for the school, school-wide movie afternoon (e.g., *Inside Out 2*). New Initiative: Stickers labeled "Ask me how I rocked" will be distributed to students demonstrating positive behaviors. Staff will review the Code of Conduct during the December meeting.
- Addressing Physical Violence: Primary concern: Increased incidents during recess/lunch due to students in the "red zone." Zero-tolerance policy paired with education on behavior expectations.
- **Executive Functioning Skills:** Executive functioning identified as a key focus area in the school plan. Resource: *Smart but Scattered* book adapted to align with students' developmental levels. Adjustments made to ensure material is more attainable for Ridgeway students.
- **Budget Priorities:** Functional spaces with appropriate furniture. 1. Literacy resources. 2. Staff support for teaching executive functioning. 3. Technology upgrades (20 devices from the school, 10 from PAC).
- **Blue Playground:** Proposal deemed feasible and well-received.

#### Kendra Arkinstall, Vice-Principal

- **Litter Management:** Classroom sign-ups for garbage cleanup, fostering student ownership. Promoting waste-free lunches and potential PAC fundraisers for reusable bins/bags. FunLunch successfully reducing waste. Staff ensuring students have enough time to eat in classrooms.
- Jerseys: Completed inventory count.

- Sandi Thorson approved the previous meeting minutes, Cameron Walls seconded.

Budget Update......Cameron Green

- Request for PAC to fund 10 iPads (\$6,899) using the remaining \$4,000 in the STEM trust account.
- Vote conducted all in favour of purchasing iPads and using the remaining STEM funds.
