- Introduce Ms. Kristy Godo Ms. Godo, Vice-Principal, joined us in January it is so great to have her on board!
- Have been cleaning up the Multipurpose room in order to offer the space to approximately 40 students as part of an ESL program.
- Black Excellence Day we had our 2nd annual assembly, which was 100% student led. The students were given last year's information and asked to add a couple new pieces of information; however, they went above and beyond; changed the material entirely and put on a very engaging assembly. They did an amazing job the students should all feel very proud of themselves.
- Volleyball Intermural in full swing unique program for ridgeway during lunch hour.
- Grade 6-7 triple ball teams; very full, lots of student interest.
- Active pathways in hallways (sensory jumping paths). BC kids get less than half the recommended exercise throughout the day. In addition to what district provides, some students applied for a grant and were successful we have also ordered an indigenous pathway. Kids intuitively know what do to with them. We will be keeping these into the coming years; not removing them after the school year.
- 30 new iPads have been disbursed into classrooms between district and PAC funding thank you for PAC contribution towards this large purchase. Admin noted that 10 additional PAC funded iPads for non-educational instructors would be an amazing help, something to add to future discussions.
- Ms. Galilee book fair wanting to have the book fair more "kid friendly" prices we need to be mindful of how many children can purchase books bookmarks being designed by students in contest.
- Student learning grades 4/7 students social emotional well-being. Spread the word; encourage parents to participate in the survey. The school, school district, etc curriculum is based solely off this survey. More information coming soon.

- Bookfair bookmark contest bookmark designs are due Feb 20 to Ms. Galilee in library
- Hot Lunch regarding food being cold once children get the food. PAC will rethink over the summer to see if there is a solution. Will need to make sure the hot bags come back to PAC for the following week. We need more volunteers in order to help keep the food warm. "We are happy to provide you with fun lunch please consider volunteering". Create a whatsapp group for volunteers to assist with last minute needs.
- Is there a hunger for a directory for playdates. We think so, this can be something we consider starting next school year.

Leaves left in piles, okay for children to play in them.
