- **Triple Ball** – In full swing – teams doing really well – thank you to coaches – students are benefiting and engaged.
- **Written learning reports** – these will go online in coming weeks. Look out for an email from admin.
- **Student Lead Conference Open House** – Tuesday March 11, 2:00pm-3:00pm and 5:30-6:30. Families will spend about 20 minutes going through classroom, sharing goal reflection connected to core competencies, etc – early dismissal 1:50pm.
